## Available to members of the Drury High School Band & Band Front

All scholarships (with the exception of the Richard M. Ziter Scholarship) are announced at the Music Department Banquet in late May. Checks are awarded after proof is presented for successful completion of the first college semester.

**1. Senior Band & Band Front Scholarships** – as the name states these are one time scholarships presented to graduating seniors in recognition of their involvement in the DHS Band and based on their scholarship and level of commitment to the band. An application may be found below:
